The Orapix System represents a new and complete solution in lingual orthodontics. The acquisition of study models by means of a 3D laser-scanner and the advanced technology CAD/CAM to realize individual jigs. Personalizing the position of the bracket using the lingual straight wire system. The virtual set-up eliminates the traditional phases of the laboratory, permitting a more accurate control, quick and direct by the orthodontist. The use of a programmed sequence of straight wires (no more mushroom shape), permits us to work with flat orthodontic wires with no bending.
